Instructions for Families

FPC will be marching in the Durham Holiday Parade on Saturday, December 8. The theme of our unit is, **FPC: Light to the World**. We are asking that children, youth, parents, adults, animals (on leash) dress warmly and wear strings of light, sparkles, glitter, etc. for the parade. FPC will provide glow-stick necklaces for everyone who marches with us. *You may park in the FPC parking lot, and then walk over to North Dillard between Main and Liberty Street at 9:00, where the parade will step off at 10 a.m.* We are unit #32 this year. Kate Busa will lead us with her truck, in case anyone gets tired and wants a ride. *You are welcome to bring wagons to pull your children. And you may also bring pets on a leash, as long as they are "friendly beasts".* **The parade concludes at Duke's East Campus**, so you should arrange for someone to pick you up there, and bring you back to your car.
