

## FLOWER MINISTRY

Thank you for volunteering to donate flowers for the sanctuary to remember a loved one; to celebrate a birth, baptism, marriage, or anniversary; to give thanks for a special occasion; or to honor a person or group. You multiply your gift by the sharing of these flowers among our FPC family who are unable to attend the worship service. Our member volunteers who deliver the flowers have an opportunity to bring love and blessings from the congregation.

- To reserve a Sunday, please sign up for your desired Sunday on the Reservation Calendar. Donations can be made by an individual, a family, or jointly by multiple individuals or families on open dates.
- Donors make checks in the amount of \$55 payable to First Presbyterian Church, with “Flowers for month/day” in the memo line. This contribution is a tax-deductible donation to the church.
- The wording for the bulletin should be given to Valerie McMillian, Parish Administrator, by no later than Tuesday of the week the arrangement is to be in the sanctuary. The message most often begins with “The flowers are given to the glory of God . . . .” followed by your personal message.

However, if you would like to request specific flowers or colors, you are welcome to visit or call Ninth Street Flowers (919 286-5640). Any additional cost that might be incurred should be included in your donation sent to the church.
