





book's title in the memo line and email John Weicher – copies available first come, first served.








#### ADULT FAITH FORMATION Lectionary Class Sundays, 9:45-10:45 a.m.




## ADULT FAITH FORMATION Journeys Class





We'll share these reflections with the community via email and social media as our common devotion. To sign up, contact <u>John Weicher</u> and he'll work with you on content and a date.




Growing thru Grief offers small group support to those who are grieving the loss of a loved one. Here is our remaining schedule for February:
